The Jammu & Kashmir State Board of School Education has launched Open Schooling under the banner of J&K State Open School for school drop-outs, older persons, persons in employment to enhance their chances of promotion, disadvantaged groups, failures from the formal system of education from both the divisional offices located at Rehari Colony Jammu and old campus Lal Mandi, Srinagar. This facility at first instance will be available for class 10th this year through a network of 22 selected Government Schools, one from each district.

The candidates desirous of completing their secondary school examination (10th Class) through JKSOS should have attained the age of 14 years on or before 1.11.2013. However there will be no upper age limit and should have passed 8th Class examination from any recognized Institution.

The application forms along with prospectus shall be available at the Office of the Principals/Headmasters of the designated Institutions on all working days from January 01, 2014 to March 15, 2014. There are limited number of seats at each Accredited Centre and therefore the selection of the candidates will be purely on first come, first serve basis subject to fulfillment of the eligibility criteria.
